CIRCULAR

Sub: Education – Technical – Examinations – Diploma Examinations – Revision (2015)
Revoking of relaxations in academic requirements – April 2022 Examinations Onwards -
Regarding.
Ref: Rules and Regulations of Revision(2015) Scheme.

In view of the restrictions in the conduct of Offline classes due to the Covid 19 pandemic situation, relaxations were made in the Rules and Regulations for Revision (2015) scheme regarding,

- a. Academic requirements on attendance and course work (Clauses 2.9, 2.10, 2.11 and 2.12) required to attend examination / promotion to higher semesters.
- b. Pattern of Question papers for Theory examinations (Clause 2.15).
- c. Duration of Diploma Programme (Tool & Die Engineering), Clause 2.1.

Accordingly,

- a. the requirement of minimum attendance required for appearing the End semester examinations or promotion to higher semesters, were not insisted for the examinations.
- b. The question paper pattern was changed restricting the maximum marks to 75.
- c. Relaxed the requirements of 12 months Inplant training for Tool & Die engineering as 6 months.

As the restrictions in conduct of classes are withdrawn and normal offline classes are commenced in the Polytechnic Colleges, the relaxations given in the Academic requirements for examinations in Diploma in Engineering / Technology / Management / Commercial practice are **revoked from the 2021-22 Even Semester Examinations (April 2022 Examinations) and the requirements as per Rules and Regulations of Revision (2015) scheme shall be in force.**

However, for the November 2021 examinations, the existing concessions shall be applicable.
